Vinudilice is a rosè wine from the Bosco vineyard, nestled in a vast forest of holly oaks (*quercus ilex*) in the territory of Bronte (Etna North), 1300m above sea level. The Sicilian name of the holly oak, *ilice*, gives it its name.

The indigenous grape varieties are Alicante, Grecanico, Minnella and other minor varieties. The 0.35 hectare vineyard is more than a century old and is planted according to the Etnean alberello (bush-training) system in a 1m x 1m scheme, equivalent to 10,000 vines per hectare. It is cultivated by hand and with the help of Gino the mule. No refrigeration, yeasts or filtration are used in the wine making process. Decanting and bottling follow the phases of the moon.
